The more you handle them, the more used they will get to being picked up and carried about as they become more docile. Guinea pigs form attachments to the individuals who care for them the most, and many of them take pleasure in snuggling up with their owners. Some, when they see their favorite persons, will also let out a high-pitched shriek of joy. There is a wide spectrum of personalities found in guinea pigs, from reserved to extroverted. However, in general, they are kind and sociable animals kept as pets. Additionally, guinea pigs, despite the fact that they are typically quiet creatures, are capable of making some quite loud vocalizations. This is particularly the case when they are shrieking with joy about a meal. When they are content and comfortable, they are also capable of producing a low-pitched purring sound. They are normally active during the day, however there have been reports of them waking up and being active at night on rare occasions. If you have trouble falling or staying asleep, you probably shouldn't keep their cage in the same room as you do. Some individuals may be surprised to learn that caring for such a little animal as a guinea pig requires a significant time commitment on their part. You should make it a point to spend at least a few hours each day interacting with

your pet outside of its cage, providing it the opportunity to exercise and explore its surroundings. Expect to spend time cleaning the cage at least once per week in addition to the regular feedings that are required of you.
