Protecting Our Forces Mar 12 2022 Infectious diseases continue to pose a substantial threat to the operational capacity of military forces.

*Protecting Our Forces* reviews the process by which the U.S. military acquires vaccines to protect its warfighters from natural infectious disease threats. The pamphlet introduces Soldiers to the Army Ethic, Values, Culture of Trust, History, Organizations, and Training. It provides information on pay, leave, Thrift Saving Plans (TSPs), and organizations that will be available to assist you and your Families. The Soldier's Blue Book is mandated reading and will be maintained and available during BCT/OSUT and AIT. This pamphlet applies to all active Army, U.S. Army Reserve, and the Army National Guard enlisted IET conducted at service schools, Army Training Centers, and other training activities under the control of Headquarters, TRADOC.
